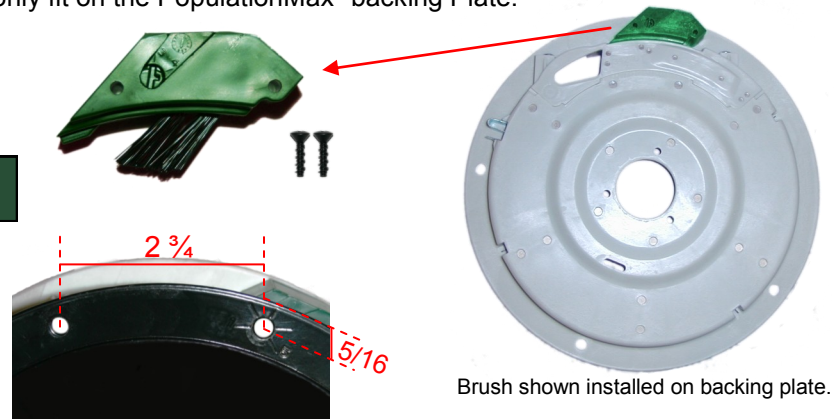


ADJUSTABLE BRUSH

Installation Instructions

The Adjustable Brush will only fit on the PopulationMax® backing Plate.

- Step 1** Remove old brush.
- Step 2** Install new brush into slot.
- Note** Note: Make sure that no bristles get caught between brush body and backing plate.
- Step 3** Fasten with two 3/4 Hi-Lo screws.
- Step 4** Drill a 9/32" hole in belt housing flange directly across from brush t-slot for adjusting lever, if needed.

Operating Instructions

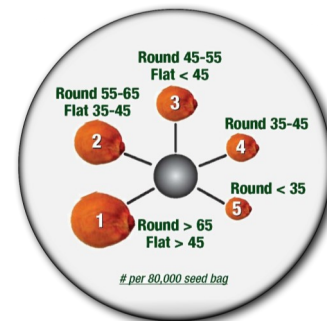
Test on MeterMax® Test Stand for maximum performance and correct brush setting with your seed.

The Adjustable Brush is made up so the #3 position is equivalent to a standard brush. This position will work well for medium sized seeds. For larger or smaller seed, the lever can be adjusted by rotating left or right to fine tune the meter's performance. See chart or sticker for details on where your brush should be set.

If meter is under-planting adjust left. ←
If meter is over-planting adjust right. →

Optional Part for the Adjustable Brush

T- Handle & hardware

The T-Handle makes it easy to tweak the Adjustable Brush. It stays in the Adjustable Brush and sticks through the meter housing for easy and quick access without removing the meter from the planter.

Annual Maintenance

- 1) Check bristles occasionally for wear.
- 2) Brushes should be changed annually or every 75-100 acres per row.
- 3) In storage make sure fingers are not distorting bristles.

Note: By rotating meter so all belt flights are hidden within the belt housing, the fingers are timed to be off the brush.

- 4) Store meters in dry, rodent free container.
- 5) Check meters on MeterMax® Test Stand
